Our Routine

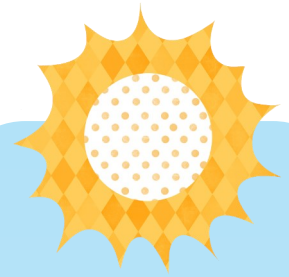
